

Senior Calf Tops New York Sale for \$5,500

For the second year, Jersey breeders from the Empire State hosted their newly formatted spring sale, New York's Next Generation Jersey Sale. The 91 lots that were struck off at this year's event on May 2 sold for an average of \$1,617.86 and a gross of \$147,225. More than half of the consignments offered were bred heifers, which sold for \$1,724.55 on average. As had been done last year, online bidding for a number of individual and group lots was made available through JerseyBid.com prior to the event. Live bidding through JerseyAuctionLive.com for the lots that carried bids kicked off the event on sale day at the Steuben County Fairgrounds in Bath, N.Y. A number of elite, tie-up animals were also auctioned at the fairgrounds.

One of the tie-up animals, a fancy, full-aged senior calf, was the high seller at \$5,500. Sam, Angela and George Colpetzer, Greenville, Pa., outlasted all other bidders to purchase Meadow Winds I Venus, consigned by Roger and Elizabeth Czadzeck, Clyde, N.Y.

"Venus" is sired by Rock Ella Impression-ET, GJPI -98, and out of a daughter of Winterplace Amedeo Starfire, PA JPI -155. A maternal sister to the dam of "Venus" is Very Good-88% with 18,740 lbs. milk, 826 lbs. fat and 689 lbs. protein.

A member of the "Mamie" cow family, Underground C-Mamie Caramel-ET, was the second high seller, purchased by Jamie and Petra Black, Constable, N.Y., for \$3,600. The 11-month-old daughter of Impressive Indiana-ET, JPI -215, is out of Underground Centurion Mamie, Excellent-92%, with three records over 17,300 lbs. milk, 970 lbs. fat and 650 lbs. protein.

"Caramel" has six Excellent and eight Very Good maternal sisters, including Underground Maddie Mamie-ET, Excellent-92%, who placed first in the milking yearling class at the Central National Jersey Show in 2010, and Underground Cocoa Mamie, Very Good-88%, who placed fourth in the junior two-year-old class at the Mid-Atlantic Regional Jersey Show in 2013 and has 18,920 lbs. milk, 1,030 lbs.

fat and 704 lbs. protein in 265 days at 3-1. "Centurion Mamie" has six Excellent maternal sisters. One of them, Underground PT N-Mamie-ET, Excellent-91%, stood first in the senior three-year-old class at the New York State Fair in 2010.

"Caramel's" grandam, Mid-Del Nate Mamie, is an Excellent-94% daughter of Shell Ray Imp J Nate-ET, JPI -139. "Nate Mamie" was fourth aged cow and the New York Spring Carousel in 2009. Her maternal sister, Underground Mammies Spark-ET, Excellent-91%, was first four-year-old at the same show and has 19,960 lbs., milk 1,012 lbs. fat and 764 lbs. protein at 4-1. Another maternal sister, Underground S Mammies Mamy-ET, Very Good-89%, was second three-year-old at the New York State Fair in 2008 and has 22,720 lbs. milk, 1,309 lbs. fat and 806 lbs. protein at 5-7.

"Caramel's" third dam is an Excellent-90% daughter of Lester Sambo, GJPI -60. Her fourth dam is Enniskillen Ren Mamie, Excellent-93%. She has a two lactation m.e. average of 17,060-743-655 and was second senior three-year-old at the Mid-Atlantic Regional Jersey Show in 1998.

The heifer calf was consigned by Underground Genetics, Pitcher, N.Y.

Jack and Colleen Button, Troupsburg, N.Y., took home the third high seller, Dreamroad Joel Chloe, for \$3,100. The full-aged senior calf is sired by Guimo Joel-ET, GJPI +76, and backed by seven Very Good or Excellent dams.

"Cloe's" dam is a Very Good-87% daughter of SV Jade Hired Gun-ET, GJPI -27. Her grandam is an Excellent-92% daughter of O.F. Barber Rocket, GJPI -8, with five lactations—three of them over 20,000 lbs. milk—and a best record of 6-11 305 21,190 4.1% 3.4% 728 102DCR. Her Excellent-91% third dam has seven lactations and a best record of 21,010 lbs. milk, 850 lbs. fat and 708 lbs. protein at 6-5. Her fourth dam, Cowbell Royal Cassidy, Excel-

lent-94%, is a three-time Grand Champion of the New York State Fair Junior Show and placed fifth in the four-year-old class at the open and junior shows at The All American Jersey Show in 1997. She has lifetime credits over 140,000 lbs. milk.

"Cloe" was consigned by Rebecca Ferry, Johnston, N.Y.

Twenty-four Jersey breeders from seven states made purchases. The volume buyer was Lynn Lee, Smyrna, Tenn., who purchased 23 lots for \$32,550.
